North Greenbush Public Library

Registration Policy

- 1. Residents of the Town of North Greenbush Library District are eligible for a North Greenbush Public Library Card free of charge. Identification, including current address, must be presented at the time of registration. Identification may be NYS driver's license, other photo ID or government issued ID. If identification does not include current address, then proof of residency will be required. Proof of residency may include a dated business document with current residential address (i.e. a phone bill, tax bill or rental lease.)
- 2. Residents of the remainder of Rensselaer County or Albany County are eligible for an UHLAN card free of charge. The same identification and proof of residency from above is required for this card.
- 3. One library card will be issued per person in the Upper Hudson Library System. Each card is valid for three years renewable upon verification of address and phone number. A fee of \$1.00 will be charged to replace a lost library card.
- 4. Children over 5 and under 18 may register for a library card with a parent or legal guardian's signature.
- 5. Adult cards will be issued to patrons 18 years and older.
